2020 Budget Proposal

The Budget and Finance Committee completed an initial draft of the 2020 Budget Proposal, and made adjustments in response to discussions held at the Executive Board meeting to present to the chapter the budget enclosed.

During preparation and review the main goals were to:

- Accommodate for a growing chapter (i.e. increase Courtesy budget line)
- Continue to become more technologically advanced (i.e. budget funds to retain QuickBooks, to purchase a mobile card reader and attendance tracker service)
- Keep chapter dues reasonable! (i.e. minimal increase from the prior year)

Over the past three years Chapter Dues were as follows:

2017 - \$180 per Soror based on 38 Sorors in the Chapter (only 36
contributing to operational expenses as 2 were undergrad transfers)
2018 - \$185 per Soror based on 35 Sorors in the Chapter
2019 - \$210 per Soror based on 34 Sorors in the Chapter (only 33
contributing to operational expenses, as 1 was an undergrad transfer)

The 2020 Budget Proposal was calculated based on 54 Sorors and Chapter Dues of \$215. This number accounts for the 11 prospective candidates, and 3 reactivations.

Please be reminded that documents do not need to be purchased in 2020 for Sorors who received them in 2019. As such the total 2020 Dues based on Soror category would be as follows:

\$350 Graduate Soror (includes Per Capita and EAF Dues) \$225 Life Member (includes EAF Dues) \$380 Reactivating Soror (includes Per Capita, EAF Dues, Sorority Documents, and Reactivation Fee)


